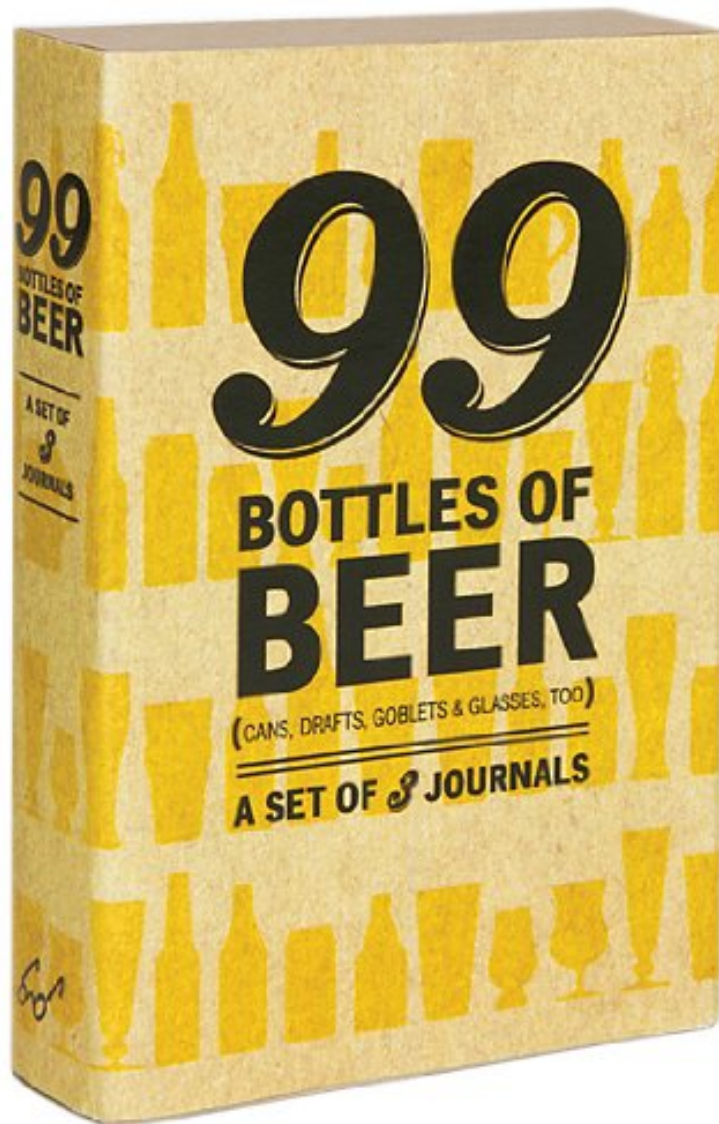

I noticed that he sometimes forgot what beers he liked and what he didn't, so I thought this might help. First off, it arrived really fast, like a day before it was supposed to. When it got here, i could hardly wait to give it to him. There are 3 separate books with enough pages for 33 beers each. There are lines for the beer name, brewer, origin, price, ibu, abc, your glass type, what the beer originally came in, aroma, appearance and flavor. There is also a color meter in which you can fill in the color closest to the beer and finally, there is my favorite feature, the flavor wheel. This is a neat little book and i would recommend it.

For craft-beer enthusiasts and home brewers, this set of mini journals is ideal for jotting down personal tasting and brewing notes. And each journal is small enough to fit into a back pocket and take to the brew pub.
