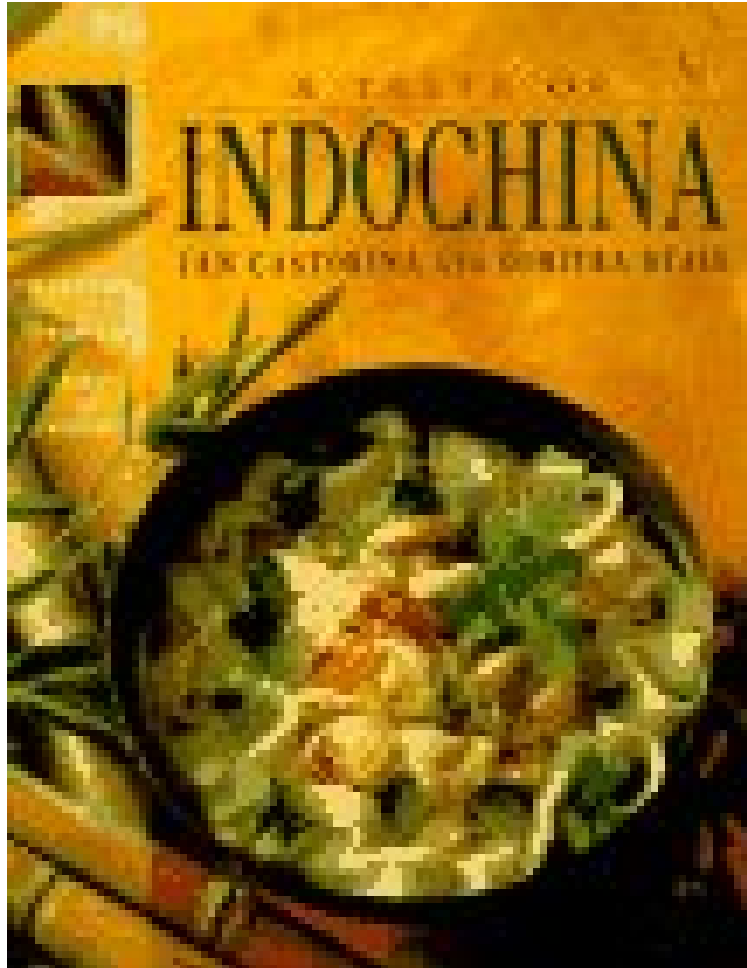

Color photos add appeal and, occasionally, helpful technical guidance. This book gives good value for the money. These dishes aren't for quick or traditional cooks: food from Thailand, Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia require a number of ingredients and some preparation time. The authors present a wonderful set of recipes paired with step-by-step photos which will entice newcomers to the cuisines of this region.
