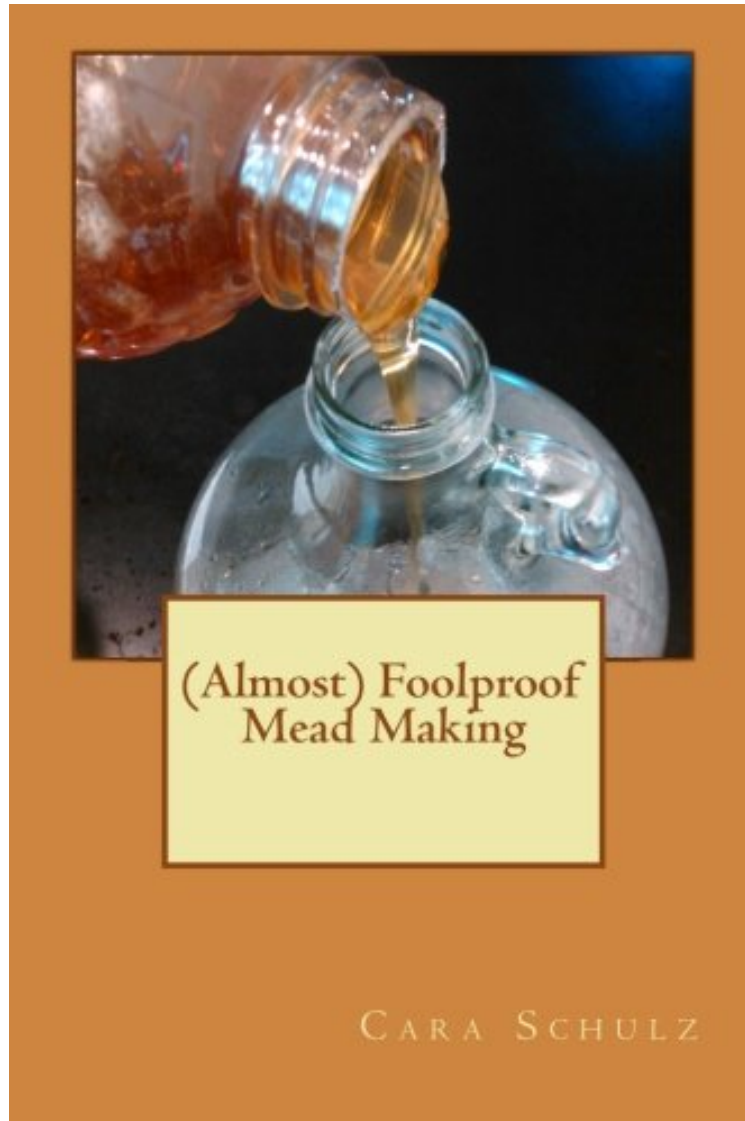

difficult for me to do, but now that I've done it, I know better! It was pretty easy! The toughest parts were pouring the honey into the jug (I started off trying to use a funnel, but it was way faster just holding it over the opening and pouring directly in) and also aerating was tough. I have weak arms, so I recommend having someone with you to help shake if you do multiple batches like I did. I'll post a follow-up later, as well as more pictures! Cheers!

Let me start by admitting I've tasted Cara's mead and she's right to brag about it. This book makes a process I've always found daunting seem possible even for me. The small batch recipe is a perfect place for a beginner to start. Cara acknowledges that there are more complicated and expensive ways to do this, which is great once you find you enjoy it. However the outlay for a beginner with some of the cost saving tips Cara provides is very reasonable. She closes the book by giving instructions for making a larger batch. She also briefly mentions some of the variations she has tried on this recipe. I would have liked at least one additional variation written out in recipe form. Other than that I find this an excellent start for someone interested in home brewing.
