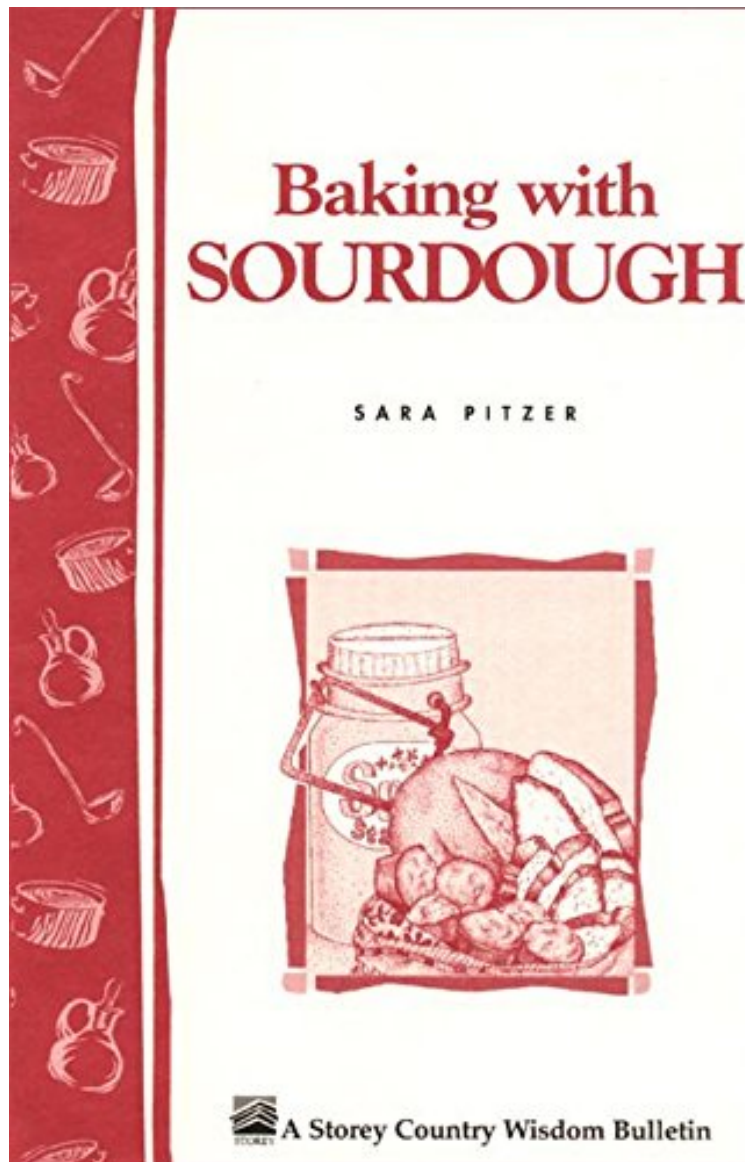

Don't let the size mislead you. There is a lot packed into this little book. I use this and Wild Bread together with a couple of other sourdough books for many recipes. I wouldn't do without any of them. And don't be afraid of sourdough! It's really pretty rugged. The pioneers used sourdough exclusively to leaven bread, so you know it can put up with quite a lot of abuse. In fact, it's seems to improve over time as it picks up complexity from various bacteria in the air. Great book.
