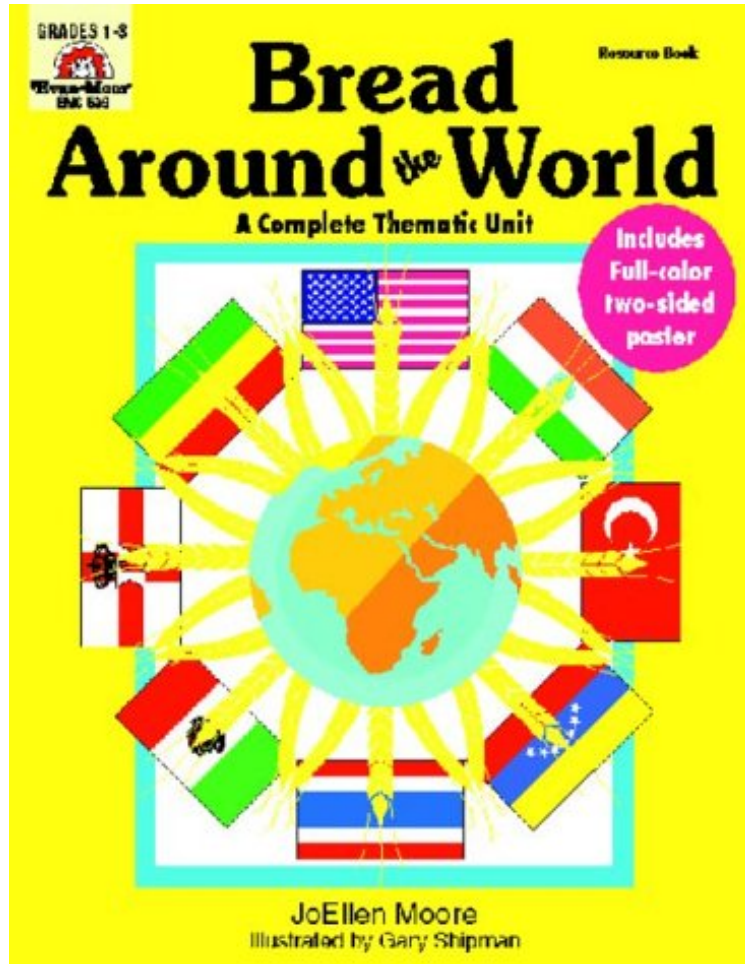

Also features a full-color, two-sided pull-out poster about the Bread Factory and Bread Around the World. Includes bibliography, and complete step-by-step instructions for all activities.
