Nice set of stencilsBy tliciousI really love the stencils that come with this kit and instructions seem pretty straight-forward but, as one reviewer pointed out, I cannot figure out how to use the letter stencils which are all on one sheet beneath the "Happy Birthday" stencil. Do you cut out individual letters and somehow sprinkle cocoa powder very gingerly on just one small letter? I guess you'd have to mask off the rest of the cake but that seems pretty impractical if you are forming WORDS, because with one letter next to another you'd mess up the neighboring letters when you masked it off. I wish the author had explained further....Still, all in all it's a really nice set of stencils. I love to decorate using buttercream and royal icing, but this set is especially nice if you are making a sugar-free cake and still want to dress it up. All you need is unsweetened cocoa powder and one of these pretty stencils!!! Attached is my first effort using this kit. The cake is a sugar- and gluten-free chocolate cake made with a ketogenic recipe. It's a 9 inch cake with two rather slender layers. I used confectioner's erythritol for dusting through and on the stencil and dabbed shortening on the stencil per the instructions. You can see the image is not 100% crisp, but it was my first try and still looks nice, I think. Plus, it's a cake - lol.3 of 3 people found the following review helpful.
