This isn't a necessity to me, but it is a plus because I love to look at the pictures. The one criticism I have is that the pages aren't glossy, so they will show every butter/egg/oil stain. To give an idea of the recipes that are included in this book, here are a few of the ones that I think sound the best: Almond and Elderflower cake with gooseberry cream Buttermilk

scones with sour cherries and Raspberry and rose water jam
Blackberry and apple crumble cake
Vanilla plum upside-down cake
Caramelised onion, thyme, and feta tarts
Chocolate, Earl Grey, and lavender cake
Eton mess layer cake (pictured on the cover)
Lemon and Rosemary cake
Pear and salted caramel cake
Spiced fig and cinnamon cake
