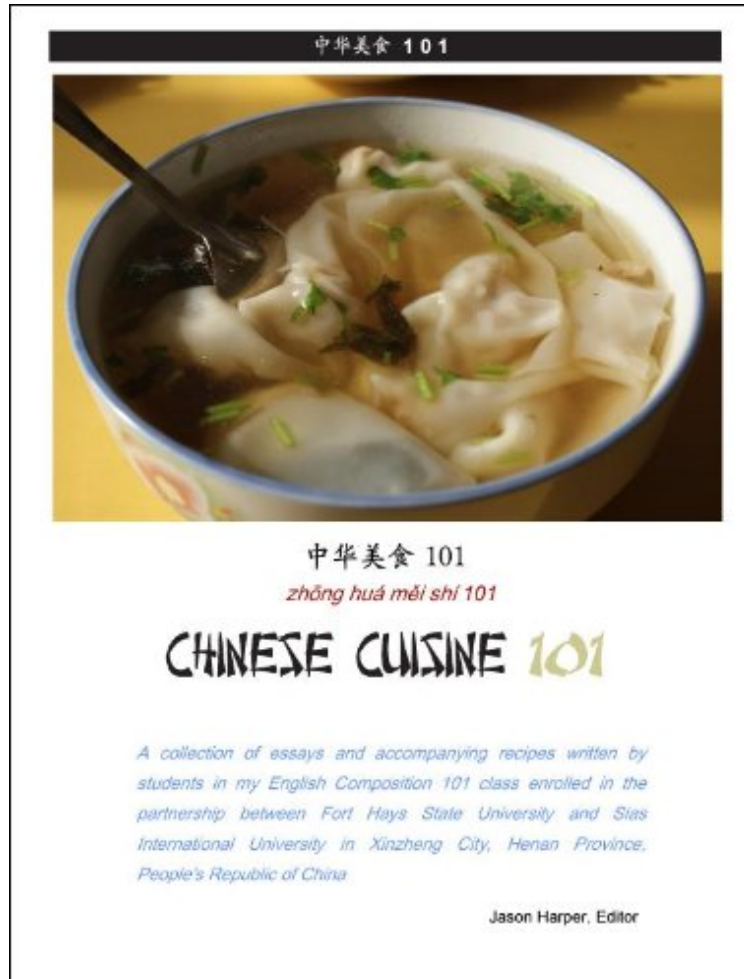

I knock off one star only because some of the recipes are a bit vague, at least for the novice cook, and some of the food terms need translating, including British terms that may be confusing to Americans. But for anyone with some experience cooking Chinese food, the recipes are fine as templates for cooking. The real treasure of this book, however, is the rich cultural history that accompanies every recipe. And some are even laugh-out-loud funny.
