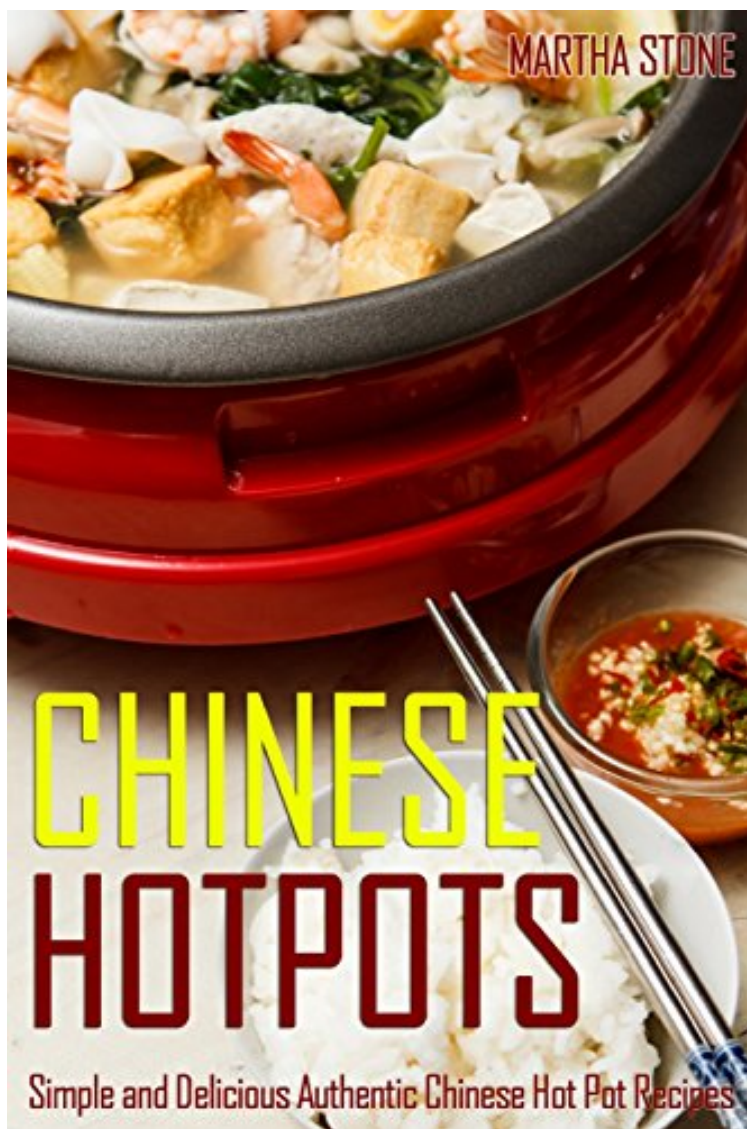

Richmond This is a good primer on hot pots and some Chinese history culture. This is not a cookbook per se. This is more of a labor of love by the author as her love of the topic shines through. As a cookbook, especially for someone looking for a lot of information on hot pots and hot pot cooking this book needs more. Lots more. There are two paragraphs devoted to choosing a hot pot, this should be a chapter all its own, with some recommendations based upon her experience. The layout of the book needs improvement; there are lists of ingredients on one page and the directions on the back of the page with the ingredients. Ingredients and instructions should be on the same page or facing page for ease of use. Use more page space, the book feels very empty due to the large text, wide margins, and the way most of the recipes are laid out. There are no photos which would be very helpful to the beginner or curious. I do like this book, because her love of the topic shows through, but as someone looking for hot pot information and recipes would have liked to see a lot more between the covers.
